

2017 Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Resident Request for Reimbursement

New PGY-1 residents in the programs listed below beginning training during Incoming Residents Week (IRW) (6/26/17) or after, must complete ACLS training prior to beginning IRW. Traditionally the Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, and Internal Medicine/Catholic Health System programs have scheduled ACLS courses for their residents during their first module of training. Residents in those programs should confirm this with their programs to ensure they do not need to take a certification course prior to beginning their residency training.
