

2017 Basic Life Support (BLS) Resident Request for Reimbursement

New PGY-1 residents in the programs listed below beginning training during Incoming Residents Week (IRW) (6/26/17) or after, must complete BLS training prior to beginning IRW. Reimbursement is available for courses *taken within three months prior and six months after the resident's start date*.

Reimbursement requests must be submitted before December 31, 2017.

Residents in all residency programs (categorical and preliminary) are eligible for reimbursement with the exception of trainees in the Pathology program. Residents in the pathology program are exempt from all certifications.

Note: Internal Medicine/Catholic Health System residents should check with their program prior to taking a certification course. This may be scheduled during your first module.

This is a one-time reimbursement not to exceed \$50.00 (reimbursement will be made for actual course cost if less than \$50.00). Only initial certification course will be reimbursed. Recertification does not quality for reimbursement.
