## Required Certification Courses & Reimbursement Guidelines for Residents

The UB Office of Graduate Medical Education (GME) reimburses select certification courses subject to the guidelines described below. For more information on how to seek reimbursement, please review the reimbursement forms that are available on the UB GME website at

## **Guidelines:**

- Only PGY1 residents are entitled to reimbursement.
- Reimbursement is for initial resident certification only; recertification is not reimbursable.
- Residents will be eligible for reimbursement for courses taken within the period three months prior to or six months after the resident's start date.
- Requests for reimbursement must be submitted to the GME office on or before December 31<sup>st</sup>
  of the applicable academic year (i.e., the year in which the PGY1 resident began training).
