Monday 6/26

- **Check-In:** Registration @ Hayes Hall Lobby - 7-7:30 am / Light Breakfast
- **Welcome & Benefits Orientation:** Drs. Berger, Cain and Abel; Jen Wilcox (403 Hayes Hall)
- **Individual Appointments at the following stations: You will receive your individual schedule for the entire week. Please pay close attention to your appointments and arrive on time.**
 - **Physicals:** Bring Health Assessment Form (Single-sided, pages 1-6 completed) + Immunization Form with titers. If titers are not available, they will be obtained during your physical. (Cary 244)
 - **Benefits:** Complete your benefit enrollment prior to meeting with the HR team (Farber 220B)
 - **UB Photos:** Professional dress; men must wear ties. Sample lab coats will be provided for this purpose. (Farber 220A)
 - **UB ID Card:** Pre-populated signature form is included in your packet for this purpose (Cary 225)
 - **VA Fingerprinting:** If your program will rotate to the VA (Cary 217)
 - **Hospital Systems' Access:** Check in with ECMC and/or Kaleida Health IT Staff (Cary 231)

- **Hospital On-Site Orientation - Location of Module 1/July rotation:**
 - Full day orientation at ECMC, Sisters Hospital and VA; AM Only for Kaleida Health Hospitals @ BGMC. Assignments to BGMC, MFSH and WCHOB will be released to programs for PM.
 - Refer to your individual hospital on-site assignment on your personalized schedule
 - Transportation to and from hospitals is NOT provided

Thursday 6/29

- **Individual Appointments at the following stations: Please pay close attention to your appointments and arrive at the location 5-10 minutes before your appointment**
 - **Respiratory Mask Fit Instruction & Testing/Physical Follow-Up:** (Cary 217 - Cary 244 - Cary 245)
 - Men who normally wear a beard are NOT required to shave, but will be required to be fitted with the PAPR hood rather than the 3M Mask
 - Men with "scruffy" beards should arrive clean-shaven to avoid having to fit with the PAPR hood (shaving supplies will be available)
 - **Sharps Practice:** How to avoid a needlestick injury (Hallway outside Cary 245)
 - **UB ID Card Pickup:** Bring one form of government-issued photo ID (Farber 220C)
 - **Standardized Patients:** Some programs will also be scheduled for this activity (Hallway-Cary 245).
